<u>Recipe and Cooking</u>	<u>Watch a firework display</u>	<u>Fact finder</u>
Cook your favourite family recipe, weighing your ingredients carefully. Take a photo of your creation to share with your class. You could share the recipe too!	Report what you saw and how you felt in any way you like. E.g. a picture, some writing or a dance.	Find out 5 fascinating facts about the Great Fire of London, King Charles II or Samuel Pepys to share with your class.
<u>Poetry</u>	<u>What is autumn?</u>	<u>What if...</u> <u>We didn't have mobile phones?</u>
Learn and perform a short poem of your choice. Challenge your family to join in!	Create 'something' to depict what autumn means to you. E.g. a drawing, collage, a sculpture, a poem or a short descriptive paragraph.	Have a discussion with your family. What could we use instead? You could make a poster to share your ideas.
<u>Creative writing task.</u>	<u>Nature Explorers</u>	<u>Make a pairs memory game.</u>
You have discovered a new country. <b>Describe what it is like there</b> How did you get there? What does it look like? What is living there? Is it deserted? What can you do there? Why should you live there?	Go for a walk and find the biggest leaf you can! Can you identify the tree it came from? Who will find the biggest leaf?	Make a memory game about a topic we have worked on at school e.g. maths sums matching with its answer OR matching nouns with adjectives e.g. frog with croaky.
