Secondary School Admissions

This online application allows you to name up to six schools. If you do not live in the borough, you can still include Richmond schools in your application. The closing date for applying for a Year 7 place is 31 October 2023, so be sure to submit your application before this deadline to secure your child's secondary school placement.
