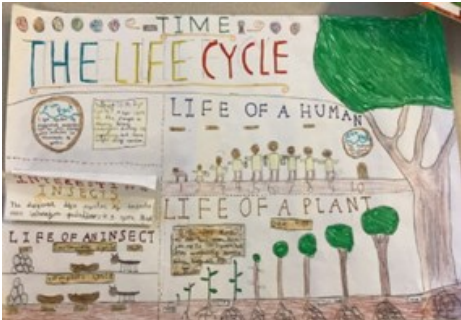
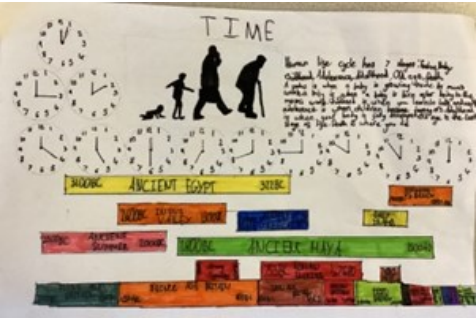

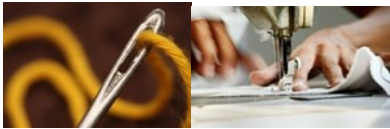

INCINERATED

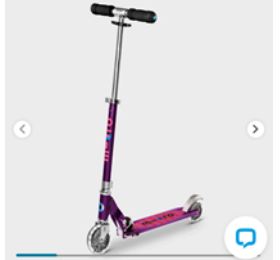
Plastic waste that is disposed of by burning it. This releases carbon, toxins and pollutants.
