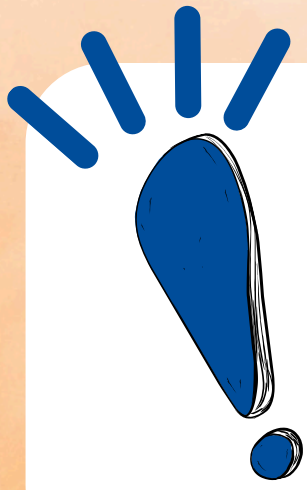

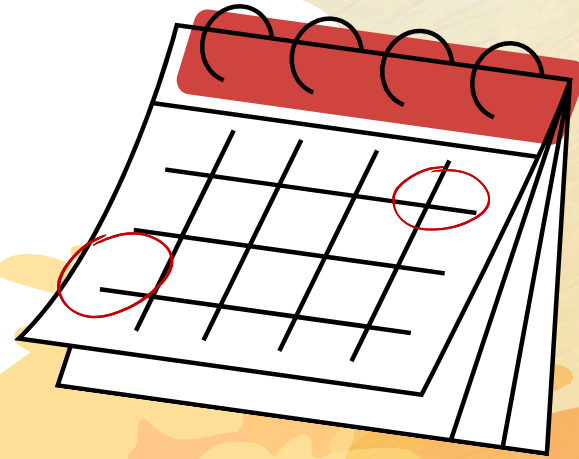

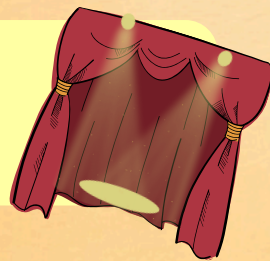

SCHOOL VALUES

Last week, we introduced our 5 new values to the children. This week we have started to look at them in more detail - about what they mean and how they can be shown.

A competition was also launched for the children to design the new logos to go with each value. If your child would like to take part, they can collect a design sheet from their class teacher. They can design all 5 values or just 1 - it is up to them! They just need to make sure their designs are clear, bold and show what the value is.

It would be brilliant if parents were able to support their children with this at home and perhaps initiate conversations around what the values mean.

DOUBLE RAINBOW!

On Wednesday, the 11th of September, I looked outside and saw a double rainbow! I grabbed my mum's phone and went upstairs as fast as I could so I wouldn't miss it. I took lots of pictures, trying different sizes and this one turned out to be the most fantastic picture. Did you know, rainbows are formed when light from the sun is scattered by water droplets (e.g. raindrops or fog) through a process called refraction. Surprisingly, double rainbows are relatively common, especially at times when the sun is low in the sky such as in the early morning or late afternoon. The second rainbow is fainter and more 'pastel' in tone than the primary rainbow because more light escapes from two reflections compared to one.
