Mosaic



All Nelson children are taking part in an exciting art project to design and replace our Mosaic.

The original mosaic at Nelson School was built and designed in 2006. Sarah, a former student

who is now 28 years old, remembers the project well. She recounts, "We had tiles broken into pieces, and we selected which pieces should be placed where to represent Nelson." This year, the school is fortunate to be working with two great artists, Tamara Froud and Mary King, on a new mosaic project. Earlier this week, the children had the opportunity to collaborate with Tamara, a mosaic artist, to develop ideas for the new design.

The Design Process

- Children across all year groups worked with Tamara to brainstorm ideas for the new mosaic design, which will be installed at the front of the school.
- This project has been funded by the Parent-Teacher Association (PTA).
- During a design day, students made a great start by drawing ideas that will contribute to the final mosaic design.

The ideas they came up with are linked to Admiral Nelson and Nelson School, including the children's favorite subjects, underwater creatures, the ship's crew, and friendships.

Next Steps

The next step in the project will be for all children to add to the larger mosaic during the arts week in June. This collaborative effort will bring the new design to life, building on the initial ideas and sketches developed by the students. The mosaic project at Nelson School is an exciting opportunity for the students to engage in a creative and meaningful art project that celebrates the school's history and the interests of the community.
